



Our Vision, Values, and Aims

As a nursery team, we will reengage children, parents, and carers, with our shared School Vision, Values, and Aims. Through shared play & learning experiences we will support children to learn about our five 'HEART' Values in meaningful ways that reflect their day-to-day experiences. We will re-engage families and children with our Nursery 'Motto' of *Be Kind, Be Safe, Have Fun*, taking time to explore these key concepts in meaningful, engaging, and age-appropriate ways together.

Supporting Children with Neurodiversity

Building on previous improvement work supporting children with additional support needs (ASN), all nursery team members will undertake professional development activities to improve our understanding of neurodiversity and autism. This will include working with experts from Perth Autism Support. We will continue embedding existing support strategies with consistency - including using visuals, Makaton, and tailored interactions - whilst also implementing further strategies to meet the needs of specific learners.

Gross & Fine Motor Skills

Through tracking activities, we have identified supporting children's gross and fine motor skills as an area of practice to develop further. We will work with parents and carers to explain and promote the importance of active, physical play to support children's wider learning and development. We will review and evaluate the spaces and experiences we provide children to support their ongoing gross and fine motor development. Team members will undertake further training to help develop our practice.
